
Gokulam Academic Meet May 2021

The academic session was based on two rare case scenarios. One was based on a case on Listeria meningosepticemia in an immunocompromised female which was presented by Dr Ashna Ajimsha. The other one was SSSS in an infant which was narrated by Dr Reshma. Both the sessions were chaired by Dr Ramani Bai J T, Professor and HOD of Microbiology.

The last talk of the session was by Dr Ashish Jitendranath, Professor of Microbiology, on "COVID19, our PCR story so far" in which he elaborated on the comparative review of the pros and cons of various diagnostic methods for the detection of COVID-19. The talk was very informative and concise clearing all the common doubts that exist, related to COVID19 testing, and also reflected on the institute's successful journey towards setting up of a molecular lab along with the confronted challenges.
